RESULT OF PROTEST AND DISPUTES TRIBUNAL



Tribunal Summary – 19 November 2025 - Salman Asif, Jandakot Park

- The Protests and Disputes Tribunal convened to review an incident in a One Day D's match.
- Evidence showed a confrontation following a dismissal, with video footage submitted.

Salman Asif's Role

- Admitted to giving a sendoff after the dismissal.
- Denied using profanity, stating he told the batsman to "walk off".
- Acknowledged making a remark about needing glasses, which he said was a response to earlier sledging.
- The tribunal determined this conduct amounted to a Level One offence: "Sending a batsman off by pointing or gestures when a wicket has fallen."
- Penalty imposed: Two-week playing ban, with one week suspended for 12 months.

Tribunal Note

- The chair issued a general warning to all clubs that repeat behaviour of this nature would attract stronger penalties in future.

Note: This matter was referred to the Review Committee who upheld the P&D's penalty.
